

Flats



This is a **FLAT**. It looks like a squished letter *b*. When you see a flat in front of a note, play the key a HALF STEP LOWER.






To remember that a **FLAT** is a HALF STEP *LOWER*, imagine being in a car and the tires go FLAT...you would sink *lower*!








Intervals


- ✓ An INTERVAL is the distance between two notes.
- ✓ You already know a few intervals: the STEP and the SKIP.

A STEP is also called a 2nd (SECOND).





A SKIP is also called a 3rd (THIRD).
