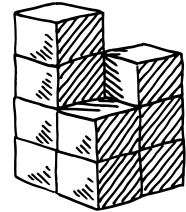




Triads Starting on Black Keys

The **D^b**, **E^b**, and **A^b** triads all have the same triangular shape on the keyboard: *black key-white key-black key*. Play hands separately.

Major Triads
Starting on Black Keys

- D^b** = D^b F A^b
- E^b** = E^b G B^b
- G^b** = G^b B^b D^b
- A^b** = A^b C E^b
- B^b** = B^b D F

The **C[#]m**, **F[#]m**, and **G[#]m** triads all have the same triangular shape on the keyboard: *black key-white key-black key*. Play hands separately.

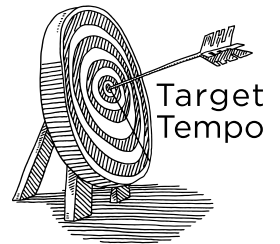
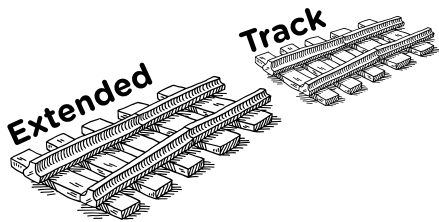
Play these minor triads hands separately.

Minor Triads
Starting on Black Keys

- C[#]m** = C[#] E G[#]
- E^bm** = E^b G^b B^b
- F[#]m** = F[#] A C[#]
- G[#]m** = G[#] B D[#]
- B^bm** = B^b D^b F

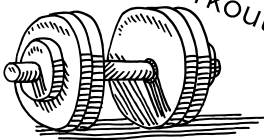
