


- ✓ Practice the RH melody.
- ✓ In this lead sheet, play the LH chords without the middle note. For example, C = C and G (no E). This is a 5th.
- ✓ Play the Chord Pattern with your LH. It switches between a 5th and a 6th.
- ✓ Play through the lead sheet with the LH only, using the Chord Pattern.
- ✓ Finally, play the lead sheet hands together, using this LH RHYTHM PATTERN:






St. Louis Blues





✓ Use this rhythm pattern in the chord chart below. Change the chords and LH notes at each new chord symbol.






✓ Add pedal. Change the pedal on each new chord.


Write a song by using a chord chart.
