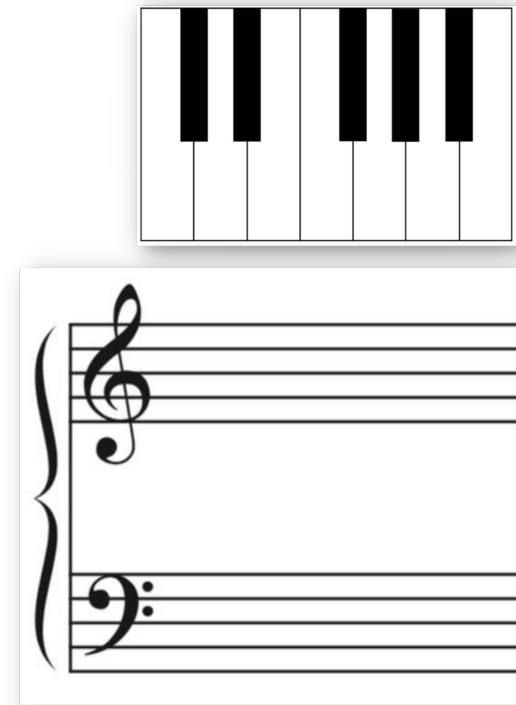

Teaching Note Names

The following pages contain graphics that I use with my own students. Please feel free to print and share as many pages as you like with your students! I like to laminate these pages and have the student use dry-erase markers. If they're online students, they can use an "annotation" feature on their tablets to write on the images.

Almost everything I do with these graphics uses multiple learning modalities to improve the student's engagement and ability to learn the notes. Be sure to have students do a combination of "say it, play it, and write it" for each new note or key on the keyboard.

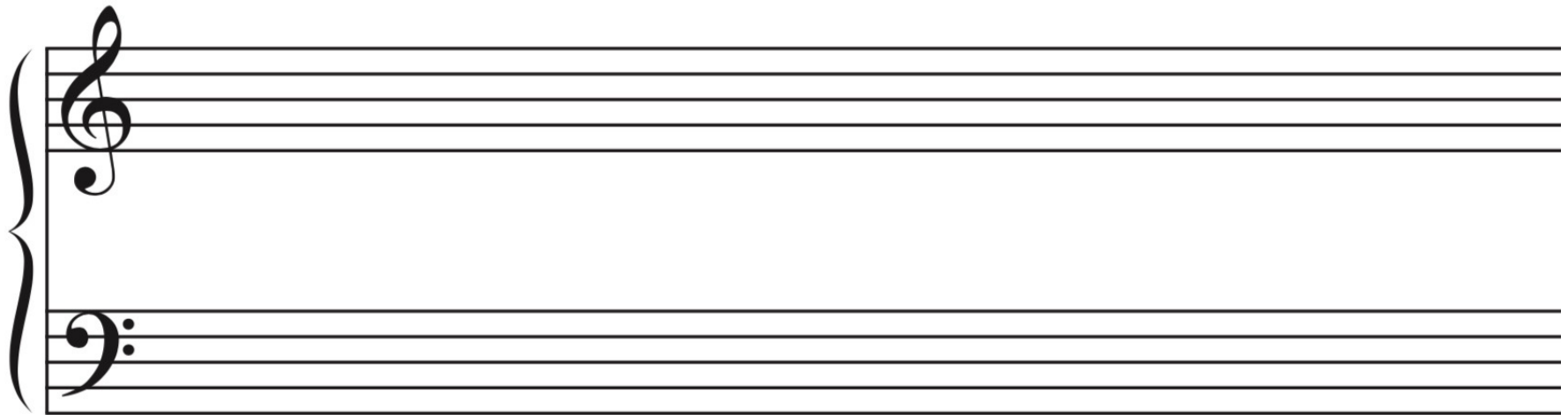
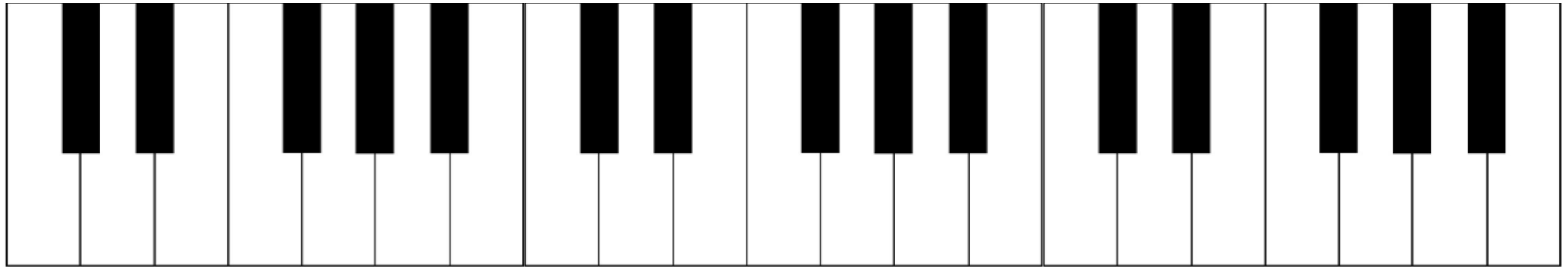
Ways that I use these with my students:

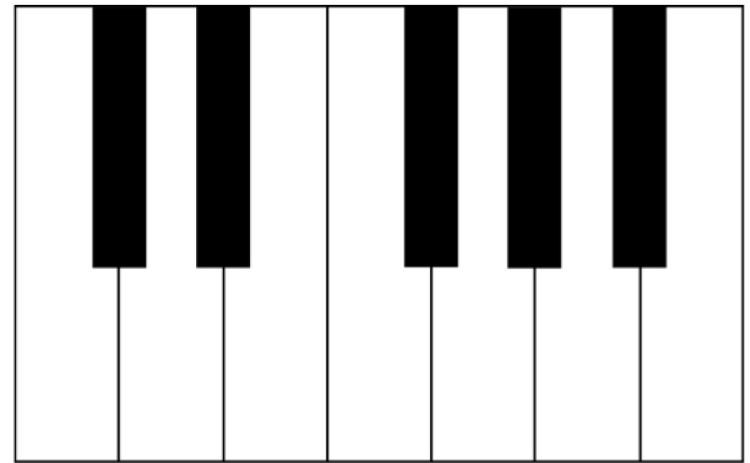
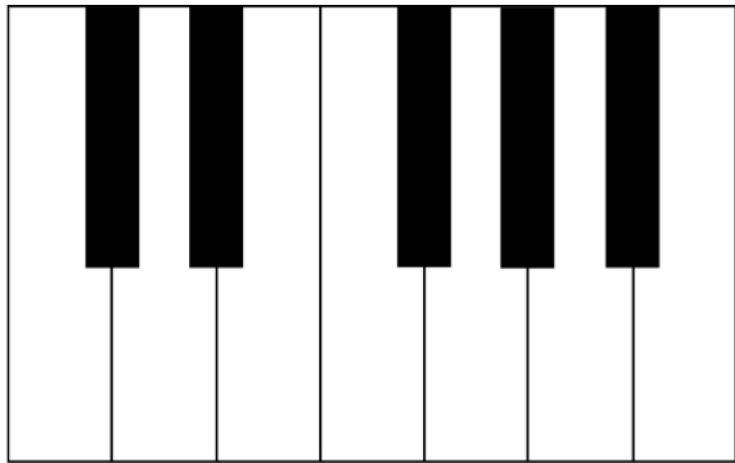
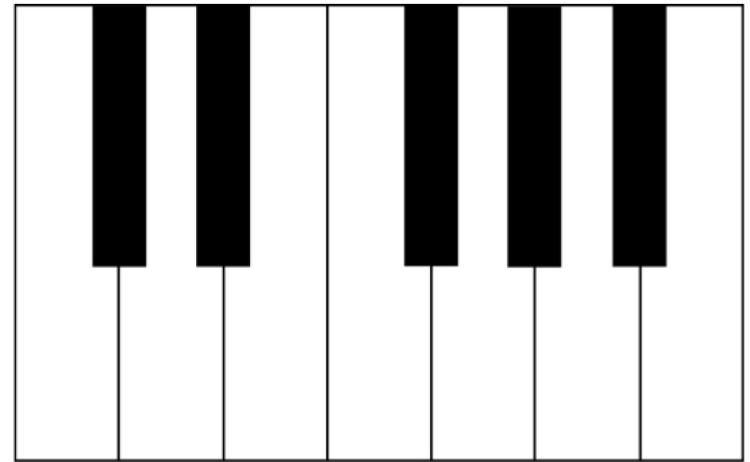
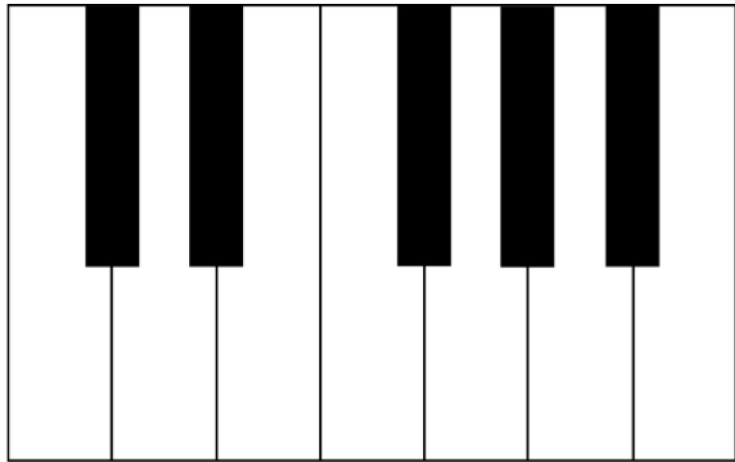
- Note identification—have students identify notes that are called out
- Interval identification (melodic and harmonic)—give a starting note and ask for an interval higher or lower than the starting note. Have students draw notes on the staff, write the letter names on the keyboard, then play.
- On the long keyboard, ask the student to write-in scale fingerings, notate the scale on the staff, then play.
- Use the keyboard graphics to teach whole steps and half steps, major and minor triads, and intervals.
- Keyboard and staff graphics: fill out either the keyboard portion OR the staff portion, and have the student fill out the other to match what you've written.
- Landmark notes—write landmark notes on the staff and ask the student to write a step up or down.

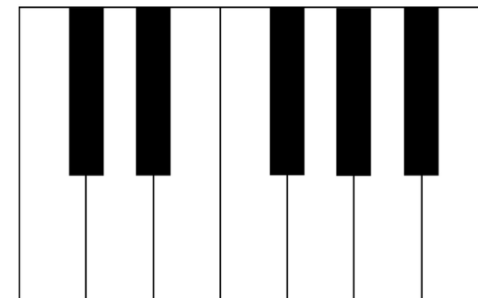
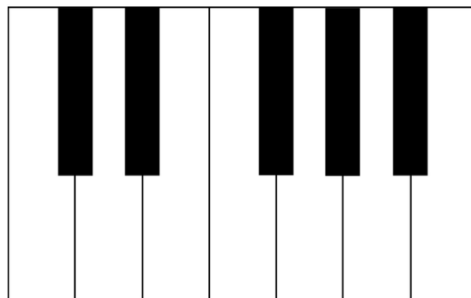
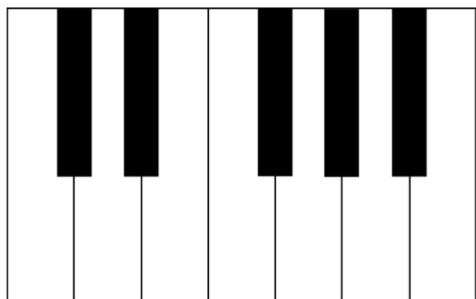
