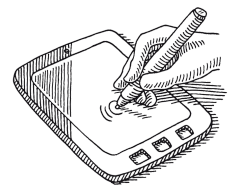

Allegro assai

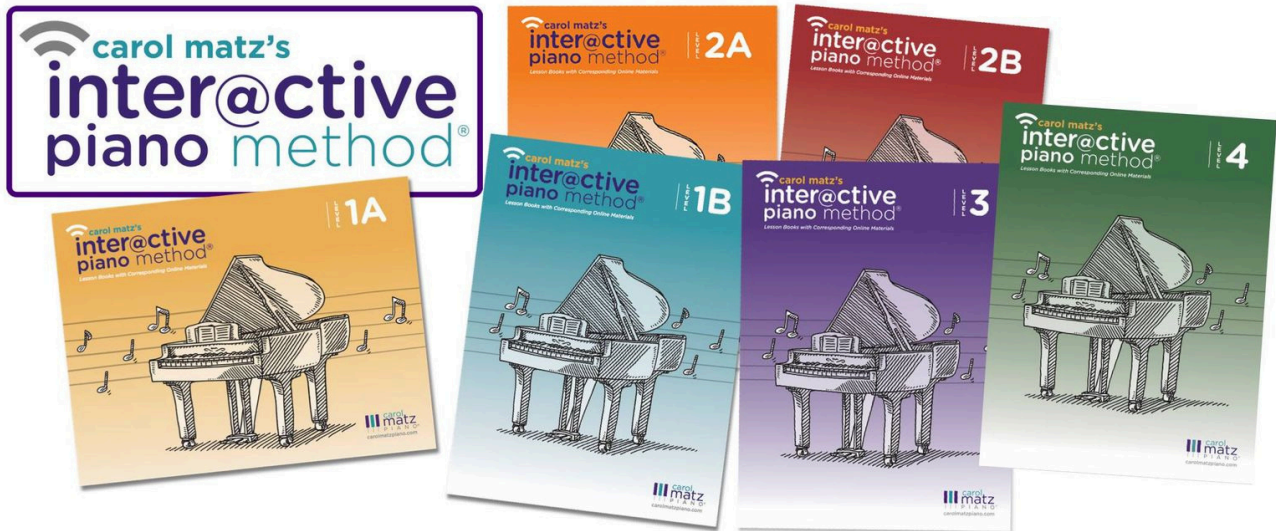

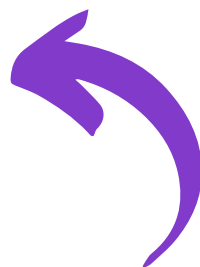
